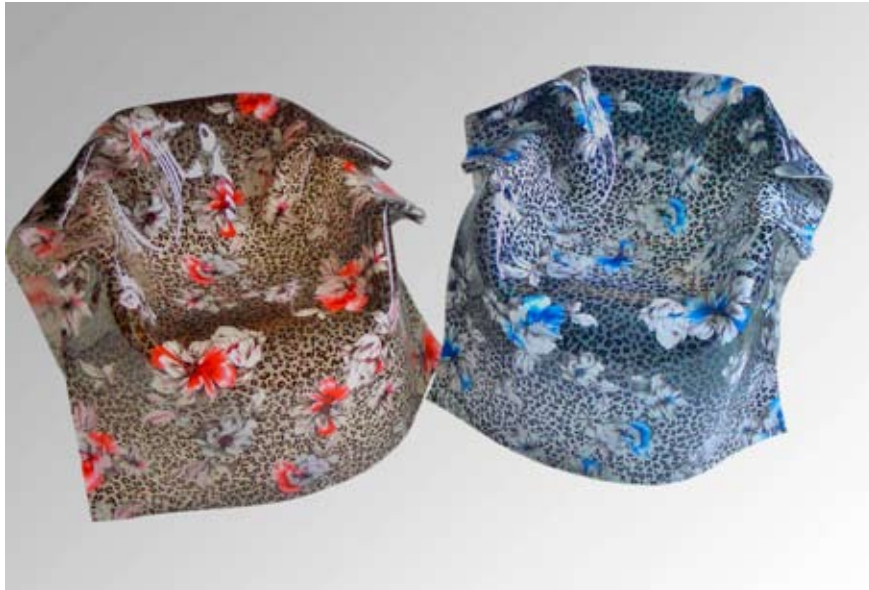

A complete collection which ranges from beds to sofas, armchairs to tables, chairs to home accessories, faithfully finished with prints taken from the Blumarine collection: the animal print in pink, green and beige, the micro butterfly and the floral pattern.

Special mention should be made of the Anna armchair, made in the fabrics mentioned above which have been “trapped” in cast transparent resin.

This innovative manufacturing process makes each chair unique and exclusive and creates soft and sleek shapes which reference the distinctive features of the brand.

The array of romantic ideas is completed with the addition of new items with modern minimalism and a geometric and clear-cut style, in the neutral colours of grey, beige and white.

The materials used for the collection are strictly natural – linen, cotton, silk and cashmere with all-Italian crafting.
